*Customer is responsible for paying to install solenoid valve if they have irrigation connected to well water prior to reuse connection.

I, the property owner, understand that reclaimed water is the highly treated, filtered, and disinfected effluent from the City of Pompano Beach's (City) reuse treatment facility that may be safely used for irrigation of residential lawns, medians, common areas, etc. I understand that, due to the chemical composition of reclaimed water, it is **not suitable for human consumption** and may not be compatible for irrigation of certain susceptible vegetation, and agree to restrict use of reclaimed water for the purpose(s) described in this application. I also agree that I will not hold the City or any of its officers, employees, agents or contractors liable for damages which may occur due to interruption of service, nor for variations in service including pressure and volume, or due to uses of reclaimed water for purposes not included in the application, and agree to defend and hold harmless the City from all claims and judgments arising therefrom.

I, the property owner, agree to allow the City's contractor to act as my agent to apply for a building permit with the City of Lighthouse Point Building Department to make appropriate plumbing modifications to connect to the City's Reuse Water System. It is understood and agreed that City representatives shall have the right to enter the above premises during normal business hours to connect or inspect the reclaimed water piping and fittings, to discontinue City utilities for nonpayment of service charges, for tampering with the service, for cross-connections with another service or water source, or for any other reason that may be detrimental to the City's Reuse Water System. It is understood that the customer agrees to become a reuse customer and will be responsible for any costs incurred for services rendered if work is canceled by customer prior to completion. It is understood that the City warrants parts/materials supplied and labor for a one (1) year period from the date of installation. It is also understood that cross-connection of any kind is prohibited and upon discovery of a prohibited cross-connection, the potable public water system will discontinue service until the contaminant source is eliminated.

City of Lighthouse Point Ordinance #0945 requires all properties in the Pompano Beach water service area connect to the Pompano Beach Reuse Water System.
